CRSA provides compassionate, state-of-the-art cancer care by improving access for patients in South Australia to novel therapies for treatment of cancer. Clinical trials have been demonstrated internationally to be the gold standard choice of treatment for patients diagnosed with cancer.

CRSA conducts phase I, II and III clinical trials and CRSA has high-level expertise in all solid tumours, including cancers of the breast, lung, male genito-urinary system (prostate, bladder, kidney and testis), female reproductive system (ovary, uterus and cervix), gastrointestinal tract (oesophagus, stomach and bowel) and melanoma.

Working alongside specialist cancer surgeons, radiation oncologists and all major medical specialties, the team at CRSA ensures each patient's cancer care is optimised, individualised, and of the highest standard.



Our Facilities

CRSA is located in a purpose-built self-contained research unit alongside St Andrew's hospital in Adelaide offering state of the art facilities in a spacious and calm environment on the edge of the South Parklands.

The location allows for convenient access to other specialists and health care options, enhancing the outcomes for patients.

CRSA has capability and experience in complex phase I and first-in-human (FIH) clinical trials. Start-up activities, including ethics, are conducted in-house with a team dedicated to streamlined, faster processes that bring novel therapies to patients rapidly.
